	<p><u>Oskar Blues G'Knight Imperial Red Ale</u> 8.7% ABV- Imperial Red Ale. 92 PTS – Beer Advocate. An amber-reddish color with thick tan head, this big red brew blends notes of toasted and caramel malt, pine and grapefruit hop notes over a dry, resin-filled sticky finish.
